Advent 3 Liturgical Year 2023

I continue to watch around me for those holy moments This weekend that we celebrate the Third Sunday of Adwe've been reading about in Matthew Kelly's book entitled "Holy Moments." Sometimes I struggle to find them but I am trying. I have to intentionally keep my eyes open for those moments in my daily life when God is calling me to do something or say something for someone who is in need of hearing God's voice or encountering Him in their daily living. That's what I find a little distressing for me – that I must be intentionally watching for those times. Shouldn't those become natural by now?

My answer is yes, they should. However, I sometimes feel like I am taking God's mercy and love for granted instead of opening my eyes and heart to notice such grace.

I was sitting and listening to Bishop Bob Casey back on November 30th when he joined us in the church for our Advent evening of reflection when I noticed someone struggling and weeping. The holidays are difficult times Peace. for many people. While I was trying to pay attention to the bishop, it was not quite so easy as my thoughts and prayers were being directed in that person's direction. I wish I could remember exactly what the bishop said at one point that made me look in that person's direction and they looked back at me. I don't know how that happens. To simply make eye contact with that person and acknowledge each other with a simple nod was holy enough; however, after the bishop's talk finished, the other person and I ap-

proached one another with hearts full of gratitude for a glance that made a difference to each of us.

vent, we give glory to God for offering us hope for eternal life. We may continue to await remembering Jesus' birth into history, but we are inching ever closer to the return of Jesus into our time. We set this hope off by a very special symbol – the color rose. The lighting of the rose candle tells us that "red flag warning" that God's promised Savior is returning sooner than we might think. Of course we know that in our head's because time marches on. Yet, it's not our heads that need to realize Christ's return is imminent, but our souls need that realization. What more do we need to do to prepare, and not simply in terms of housekeeping or decorating? Wouldn't it be better to have your heart decorated?

Carry on. The Savior is near! Keep hoping and praying to have more holy moments in your life too.
