## A Note from the Associate Pastor's Desk

### Time marches on...

In these days of the Annual Catholic Appeal, it's also a great time to remember that Lent is approaching – just over two weeks away! Ash Wednesday is on March 5<sup>th</sup>.

We can always think of how we have spent our Lent trying to be a little holier before the celebration of Easter – no candy, no soda, or social media. We've promised to read more, pray more with the Scriptures, or watch our language. We celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation as a community (not using general absolution). But what might be something different for us this year?

St Cletus has just such an opportunity for trying something different in preparation. We are a designated pilgrimage parish in this Jubilee Year of Hope – Pilgrims of Hope. That means we could have a great influx of people who will be visiting our parish from all over the Archdiocese – even if that simply means to come and pray for some time in our Church. During Lent, St. Cletus always offers a little something extra like Stations of the Cross as many parishes do. We have TWO Evenings of Prayer and Reflection scheduled, both by one of the most dynamic priests in our Archdiocese, Fr. Mike Knotek. And then, there is also our newest opportunity that was thought up by the Parish Pastoral Council – kindness cards. If you have not seen these business card-sized reminders of how spreading kindness can lead us to being a people of hope for others, they are strategically placed with the Canticle holders near the doors of the church. Try one!

On the back of the kindness card, there is an email address [kindness@stcletusparish.com](mailto:kindness@stcletusparish.com) where we are all invited to share the random acts of kindness we may see or experience that potentially could give a reader the gift of hope they need to know still exists in the world.

Those are just a few ways that we can see to it that not only are we trying to improve our own souls this coming Lent, but that we also want the same thing for all of humanity. Kindness may begin by a very small act toward another, but we just don't ever know how one act may inspire the other or someone else who sees our action and thinks, "I wish someone would do that for me." A person with that thought might think, "Maybe I can do that or something similar for somebody." And then, you see, it's a matter of a the "domino effect" – knock over one, then a chain reaction begins with one domino after another falling. Imagine the domino as an act of kindness – simple as opening a door for someone who has his or her hands full to helping a child who can't find a parent in a shopping mall.

There is proof of how good we feel about ourselves when we perform random acts of kindness. The paradox is that we are not the intended target of those random acts.

"Humbly regard others as more important than yourselves." (Phil. 2:3b) Offer hope!
