Pastor's Note

"The Lord remained standing before Abraham,"

Gen. 18:22b

Dear Parishioners,

As we grow in our relationship with the Lord, we notice that He is always with us. He remains standing before us. He is always ready and available for us. He wants to be close to us. He readily shares His kindness, mercy, healing, and love with us. He offers us the support we need to remain with Him and in Him. He allows us to bring to Him our concerns and petitions on behalf of others. He always provides.

As I grow in my relationship with the Lord, I continue to learn and be amazed at how the Lord delights in helping us. It seems to me that all that we have to do is to turn towards Him more often. Once we are able to do that, the Lord always provides, and things turn out to be better than we were expecting. It is from this experience that I share with you some important updates.

First, I am pleased to let you know that our parish has a new Director of Faith Formation for Children. The Lord has touched the heart and soul of Lawrence Manetti who has accepted the position effective August 8th, 2022. He served as Principal at St. Joseph Parish School in Summit, for 24 years. Since July 2022, he served at St. Stephen Deacon and Martyr Parish, Tinley Park, as the Director of Faith Formation for Children. In addition, Laurence served as the chess club coach for our school this past year. He has a strong education background, wisdom, experience, but above all, he is a man of faith. I am confident that not only our children but all of us will greatly benefit from his presence, ministry, teaching, and leadership. Let us extend Lawrence our warm welcome. Please know my appreciation for your prayers and support.

Second, I will be holding a special Gathering/Meeting on Saturday, August 13, 2022 (10:00 AM to Noon) in the Parish Center with all catechists to introduce and welcome to our parish Lawrence Manetti as the new Director of Faith Formation for Children. Please accompany us with your prayer.

Third, I am happy to let you know that I will be having an evening of prayer and reflection with our Lectors (August 3rd) and Extraordinary Eucharistic Ministers and Sacristans (August 10th) in the Parish Center. At each evening, I will be joined by Fr. Michael Novick, Associate Pastor, Tina Norton, Pastoral Associate and Juanita Avila, Director of Hispanic Ministry. This is something I wanted to have some time ago. I am grateful to the Lord that he is now giving us a concrete date and time for us to gather so that we can be with one another and him. Please keep us in your prayer.

Fourth, with regards the To Teach Who Christ Is obligation I share the following message that comes from Jim Dion, Business Manager.

In order to pay down its \$675,000.00 "To Teach Who Christ Is" obligation to the Archdiocese, the parish made two payments in Fiscal Year 2022, which ended June 30, 2022. The first payment was a transfer of \$24,890.26 (the balance of funds from the parish TTWCI account which was held at the Archdiocesan bank) to the Archdiocese on May 31, 2022. The second was a check paid from parish funds to the Archdiocese in the amount of \$25,000 on June 3, 2022. The total amount paid to the Archdiocese in Fiscal Year 2022 was \$49,890.26, leaving the amount still obligated to be paid to the Archdiocese at \$625,109.74. Payments will continue to be made in Fiscal Year 2023, which started July 1, 2022.

May our awareness of the Lord continue to deepen so that we can allow him to share his goodness with us.




CATECHISTS NEEDED

ANNE AND JOACHIM

Can you think of five words that describe your grandparents? Ask each person in your family to add their own five words to the list. What do you call your grandparents when you talk to them? What are some things you like to do with your grandparents?

On July 26 we remember St. Anne (her name means "grace") and St. Joachim (his name means "God will establish"), the parents of Mary, our Blessed Mother. That makes them the grandparents of Jesus. Did you ever think about Jesus having grandparents like yours? What do you think Jesus liked to do when he was with his grandparents?

We don't know much about Anne and Joachim. They aren't mentioned in the Bible, but our Catholic tradition tells us that they were people who were faithful to God. They prayed for a child for many years, and when Mary was born they dedicated her life to God. We can imagine that they were good parents because we know that Mary loved God and lived a holy life doing God's will. She must have learned to do this from her parents, Anne and Joachim.

The basilica of Sainte-Anne-de-Baupré in Quebec is dedicated to Jesus' grandmother. You can take a virtual tour of the inside on its website. Like Mary's shrine at Lourdes, many people travel to Quebec and the church of St. Anne to pray for the grace of healing.

On the feast of St. Anne, try to connect with your grandparents. You can do that in many ways. Share with them the words you used to describe them. Remember a time you enjoyed spending with your them. Say a prayer thanking God for the blessing of your grandparents. If you didn't know your grandparents, ask a relative to tell you about them. Ask your parents about their grandparents, too.




