





# Why do I support the Capital Campaign?

When we joined St. Cletus 11 years ago, we quickly appreciated that we were joining an "extended family". As our immediate family grew and we had to decide about what school to send our kids to, we realized our "extended family" was the right place for our children to go to school. Selfishly, we both felt that having a new parish center would be beneficial for our children as they went through their days at St. Cletus. What we realized as we became engaged in the capital campaign process is that this isn't just for the school; this is for the entire parish. In conjunction with us learning that, we also see it as our gift to the generations of families that are still to come to St. Cletus Parish. We have been left a wonderful legacy by our predecessors and we feel it is our obligation to leave something for those who follow us.

## When was our last capital campaign? What was it for? How much did we raise?

These are questions that are often asked of the *Living our Faith*, *Building our Future* capital campaign committee.

The last capital campaign, the Tower to Tomorrow, was almost 20 years ago. In 1993, a large number of capital repairs / improvements needed to be made to our parish facilities. One item was that the church tower needed to be removed because it was falling apart. Over the course of four years, approximately 1.7 million dollars were collected to begin this and many other needed projects including some tuck pointing, a school roof, parking lot maintenance with a new drainage system, existing plumbing, heating and electrical concerns, settlement of Archdiocesan debt, as well as the establishment of a school endowment fund.

The tower was taken down. Before the new tower could be built, the parish was faced with unexpected financial demands including plumbing and heating issues in the rectory, as well as a Village of LaGrange street assessment. Because of these unexpected expenses the replacement tower was never constructed, but many needed repairs, improvements, and financial concerns were addressed benefiting all those who use the parish facilities.

Today we are faced with updating and expanding our parish facility to meet our growing needs, as well as not forgetting the existing structures. The goal of the Living our Faith, Building our Future is to raise five million dollars. Four million dollars are targeted for the new parish center; the remaining million will be used to begin to address current building issues (e.g. windows, doors, HVAC). The funds already collected are on deposit with the Archdiocese, earning interest and will remain on deposit until sufficient funds are collected to start construction. The hope is that our parishioners continue to be as generous as they were 20 years ago and our new parish center will soon be a reality!

# YEAR OF FAITH

#### An Unbroken Chain of Faith

by Damon Owens

"Faith is a personal act—the free response of the human person to the initiative of God who reveals himself. But faith is not an isolated act. No one can believe alone, just as no one can live alone. You have not given yourself faith as you have not given yourself life. The believer has received faith from others and should hand it on to others. Our love for Jesus and for our neighbor impels us to speak to others about our faith. Each believer is thus a link in the great chain of believers."

For most of my life, I thought my granddaddy was the pastor of the Shiloh A.M.E. Zion Church in Asheville, NC. I grew up hearing stories of Rev. Owens from my dad: How he prayed for days in his "prayer closet," interceding for someone, or how he traveled out to the "country," preaching to those far-flung believers in the (even more) rural North Carolina backwoods. I still hear him pleading for God's blessing and protection over us in those last few minutes of every childhood visit. I can still recall what it felt like, all dressed up before dawn, kneeling with my sisters in his living room for what seemed like forever. My granddaddy prayed with intensity, conviction, and joy.

We may have doubted that his prayers would ever end, but we never doubted that this man loved Jesus Christ. I have only recently come to realize the impact of his faith on me.

In 2002 when I was discerning going into apostolic work full-time, one of my father's most encouraging observation was that I would be following in the footsteps of "Daddy." It turns out my granddaddy wasn't a pastor but an itinerant preacher. A gardener formed in the faith of his father, he got a call from God to "go and teach." And he did, for 50 years.

#### **ACTION STEP**

Make a list of critical links in your chain of faith. Who was a vital part of your faith formation—and on whose list might you be found? Offer your own prayer of thanksgiving for those who gave you your spiritual heritage, and ask for protection for those God has entrusted into your care.




