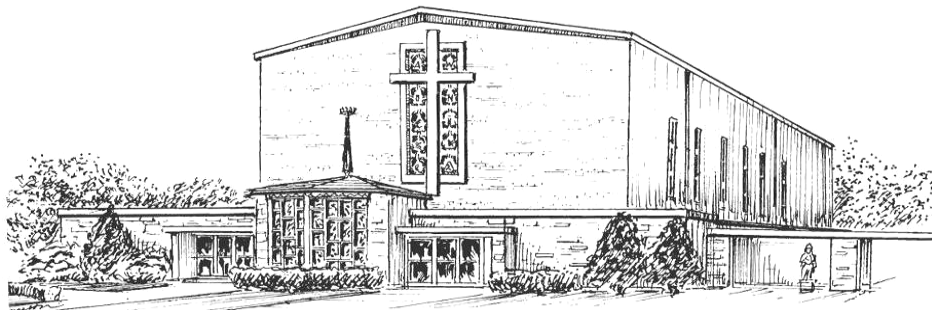

## **NOTES FROM FATHER BOB...**

### **PENTECOST 2013**

*A teacher was asking the children the names of their brothers and sisters. One five-year-old explained that she had a new baby brother, who was to be baptized the following Saturday; he was going to be called Euan. "That's a very nice— but unusual— name, Andrea," said the teacher. "I suppose he's going to be called Euan after a family member or other relative?" "No, teacher," replied Andrea. "He's going to be called Euan after the Holy Spirit." "After the Holy Spirit?" queried the teacher. "But the Holy Spirit isn't called Euan, is he?" "Oh yes, teacher," replied Andrea. "Our parish priest always says: ...with YOU-AND the Holy Spirit." We are not told what the teacher said in return!*

*Of course, when small children seem rather hazy about the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity, we can make allowances. The tragedy is when adults fall into the same category, for as today's readings make clear, the Holy Spirit is essential to the life of the Church and to the life of each member of the Church.*

*Our first reading takes us to an upper room in Jerusalem. There Mary and the disciples are engaged in earnest prayer. They've been through a most eventful few weeks. Not long ago they had been devastated by the death of their Master; then on Easter Sunday, sorrow had given way to bewildering joy with the news that he had risen from the tomb. But that was fifty days ago. Some of them had seen Jesus ascend into heaven, but even that couldn't be the end of the story. After all, today's gospel recalls that it was in this same upper room, on the night of the Last Supper, that Jesus promised his friends that he would not leave them orphans, but would send them the Holy Spirit – the Paraclete or Advocate – who would guide and protect, lead and inspire them in the days ahead.*

*That promise is about to be kept – and in dramatic fashion. A violent wind is felt throughout the house. Tongues of fire rest on the head of each person. There is preaching in tongues so that people of different nations can understand, and many are converted. These are the events which announce the coming of the Holy Spirit: the Church springs into life.*

*When Pope John called the Second Vatican Council, he said that he wanted it to bring a new Pentecost. Of course, the Holy Spirit has never left the Church since the first Pentecost day. If that were to happen, the Church would simply cease to be; it would lose its soul. Nonetheless, in every age the plea is made—it should be our plea today—that the Holy Spirit will come again, in the sense that the Spirit's presence will be felt in a renewed and reinvigorated Church...a Church more responsive to grace and better able to spread the fire of love throughout the world.*

*However, the Holy Spirit is not only at the heart of the Church's life; the Spirit is at the heart of the life of every Christian. The Spirit's coming to us was a good deal less dramatic than the coming we have heard about today, but it is no less certain. In our Lord's own words, the Holy Spirit "abides with you." He goes on to explain that those who love him will be loved by the Father, and then by he and the Father. Where the Father and Son are, there too is the Spirit—which will come and make a home in those who love Jesus.*

*We also hear those incredible statements of St. Paul: "the Spirit of God" he says, "has made his home in you"; without that Spirit you would not belong to Christ, who will bring about your resurrection from the dead; whenever you cry out "Abba, dear Father!" it is the Spirit who is bearing witness to the fact that you are a child of God, joint heir with Christ to the glory of heaven.*

*Whether or not Andrea's little brother is named after the Holy Spirit on his baptismal day, one thing is beyond question: the Holy Spirit will make of him a living temple, just as we were made his living temples on the day we were baptized. Therefore, St. Paul urges us not to live "in the flesh," as though we had only our own poor human resources to depend upon, but rather "in the Spirit," because, in fact, God's power is at our disposal. On this day, then, we pray for the Church at large, but also for ourselves, that our hearts may receive an outpouring of the strength and vitality of the Holy Spirit, who has power to renew us and the face of all the earth.*

## THE DAY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

John's Gospel tells us that when Jesus "breathed" on the disciples, the Holy Spirit came into them, empowering them to forgive sins and to gather all people into union with one another.


The book of Genesis had explained the divisions among nations with the story of the Tower of Babel. In rebellious pride, human beings had struggled to become equal to God. The result was chaos, strife, the inability even to speak the same language among themselves. Today's reading from Acts tells how the Spirit has just the opposite effect. Strangers from many nations hear and understand one another, each in his or her own tongue.

This message of unity in the Spirit is repeated in the reading from Corinthians. There are many gifts, many ways to serve. One way is not "higher," nor one person "better" than another. There is but one Spirit, who accomplishes all the different works we do, acting through us.
