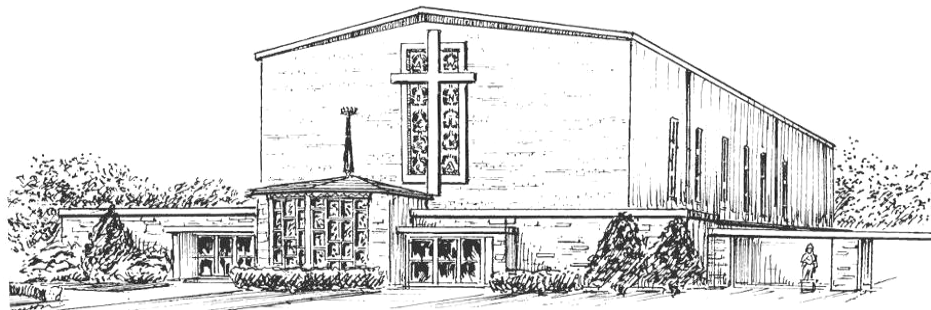

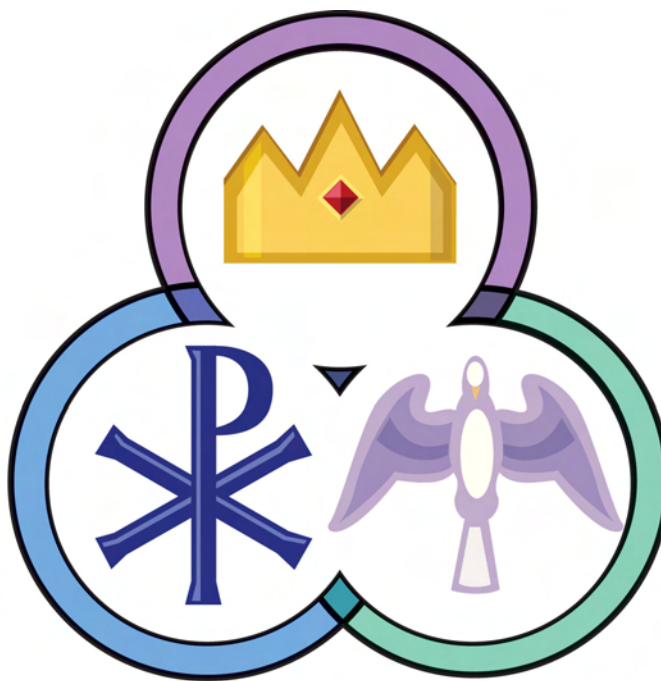

## **NOTES FROM FATHER BOB...**

### **THE MOST HOLY TRINITY 2013**

*We are all fascinated by the mysterious. Children love stories that lead them into a world that taxes their imaginations and enchants them. In the Middle Ages, mystery plays provided a wonderful way not only of entertaining people but also of teaching them about the great biblical stories and the truths of the faith. We still speak about these truths as the mysteries of faith; and indeed after the words of consecration at Mass we are invited to proclaim the mystery of faith.*

*If you were asked to define the word “mystery”, what would you say? Most of us would probably lean heavily on the fact that a mystery is a doctrine or teaching that ultimately is beyond our understanding, and of course at one level we would be right. But there is also a danger that we may conclude that therefore we can understand little or nothing about such a mystery: that it has to be taken on faith alone. And of all the mysteries of faith, the one about which we may be most tempted to think in this way is surely the Trinity: the mystery of the three Persons in the one God. St. Patrick reminded us that even in nature we see that three can be united in one; and the symbol that Patrick used, the shamrock, has become the symbol of the Irish nation. But can we move our understanding of the Trinity beyond it being a mathematical puzzle? The scriptures to which we have listened today offer us a great opportunity to do just that.*

*When were you last at play in the presence of God? The book of Proverbs gives us an amazing description of the Wisdom of God, who cries aloud: “I was by (the Lord’s) side, a master craftsman, delighting him day after day, ever at play in his presence, at play everywhere in his world.”*

*This is a wonderful image of God: a God at play and delighting to be at play with us too. Although the author of the book of Proverbs had not heard all that Jesus would tell us about his Father and the Spirit, he was able to describe God in this wonderfully attractive way; so different from some of those other images which can lead us to think God as far away and remote from us. Yet all through the Old Testament the people were aware that theirs was a God who was close to them and involved in everything that happened to them.*

*In all his letters St. Paul seems almost desperate that his readers should realize that the coming of Jesus has confirmed this truth of the closeness of God. Now, because Jesus, we can see that we are invited to be part of the family of God. We are his sisters and brothers, and therefore children of God our Father, heirs to the kingdom of God. This is how we are to understand the Trinity: it is God revealing God to us; it is our invitation to live the life of God, to live in a state of grace and ultimately to share God’s glory.*

*Today’s feast is one that calls on us to be full of gratitude for our faith and to celebrate with one another God’s closeness to us. As we continue with our Eucharist, the great prayer of thanksgiving, we will be reminded that once again we are caught up in the mystery of the Trinity. Soon you will see the priest outstretch his hands over the gifts of bread and wine – the gifts that represent you and me and all our prayers – and the prayer is that the Holy Spirit will come upon those gifts so that Christ may be present among us as our food and drink, uniting us in his life and love. And what does Christ do? He gathers us and our prayers, and presents us to his Father. All that the Father has is Christ’s: he and the Father are one; and his prayer is that we may all be one too.*

*We are thinking about a mystery and in this life we will never grasp its full meaning, but it is not entirely beyond us. Christ became human so that he could speak to us in our own language about God, and he told us about his Father and the Spirit. And remember, the Spirit leads us to the complete truth.*

# Keep

In his first letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul preserves the words of Jesus at the Last Supper:

"This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me" (1 Corinthians 11:24). The action of doing and saying what Jesus said and did at the Last Supper is an act of remembrance that recalls and makes present his saving mysteries. This action also keeps or holds the mystery of his Death and Resurrection close to us.

When we keep the mystery in our worship and in our lives, we can draw its saving power into ourselves and into the circumstances that we daily meet. Even more, we keep the Eucharistic mystery not just to hold onto it for ourselves but to be ready to share it with others. When forces of death or sin seem overwhelming for us or for others, we draw from the mystery that we have kept from the celebration of the Eucharist.

### FOOD PANTRY UPDATE

- Our Food Pantry received 3 1/2 tons of food as one of the recipients of the U.S. Post Office May 11 Food Drive. (If we had to buy this food from the Greater Chicago Food Depository, we would have paid about \$3,550, and if we had to pay regular retail prices it would probably be double that amount!)

**NSTA CONFERENCE**

Michelle Abbate and Rande Pauly, science teachers at St. Cletus School, had the wonderful opportunity to attend the National Science Teachers Association (NSTA) conference in San Antonio a few weeks ago. The conference began by listening to the famous Bill Nye the Science Guy speak. They attended several workshops especially dealing with S.T.E.M (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) experiments, using technology in the class, and effective science teaching techniques. They created balloon cars, designed hydroelectric powered systems, experimented with chemistry in a bag, dissected a frog, made ice cream in two minutes, and learned a variety of other hands-on activities. Meeting and collaborating with other science teachers added to the educational experience.

**7<sup>TH</sup> GRADE TO BROOKFIELD ZOO**

On April 25, the seventh grade students (pictured above) attended Brookfield Zoo for a field trip. The students participated in a science inquiry class where they acted as zoologists and observed African Painted Dogs. They observed them for 10 minutes and tallied when it was eating, resting, playing, etc. Once we returned to the classroom, the students graphed and analyzed their results. The class emphasized inquiry in science. After lunch, the students had the opportunity to explore different exhibits in the zoo.

### SEEKING TO UNDERSTAND THE TRINITY

If you sometimes find the Church’s teachings incomprehensible, be encouraged by today’s Gospel. Recognizing how bewildered his disciples have become, Jesus says, “I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now.” Then he promises that “the Spirit of truth” will come to make things clear.

Even with the coming of the Spirit, we never fully understand. Today we hear the ancient poetry of the book of Proverbs, singing of God’s wisdom “playing on the surface of his earth,” delighting in humankind. We hear Paul boasting of his joy—not only in the blessings God sends, but even in “our afflictions.”

Theologians wrestle with the mystery of the Trinity; with the help of the Spirit they make that divine mystery a little more clear to the Church. We understand a little. But mostly we listen, we pray, and we ask the Spirit for more clarity.
