A Note from the Pastor's Desk

A Note from the Associate Pastor's Desk

As we enter November and move closer to the information meeting for Compassionate Care on November 14 at 7pm in the Gallagher Room, I have been refreshing my mind with a book that has a history of how Christians/Catholics have celebrated life in the face of death. Of course, I know that we can celebrate life because Jesus suffered, died, and rose from the dead as the Father promised. We received, in baptism, the invitation to follow Jesus through the waters of death so as to be able to come up from those waters as clean as our souls were at the moment God created them in order to receive the gift of everlasting life.

Something I may not have made very clear when I first wrote about re-growing the Ministry is that it is not simply for women. I know that when it was created nearly 2 decades ago, there were plenty of men who were instrumental in sharing their hearts in all aspects of the ministry – from meeting and planning with families, to visiting wakes, to leading prayers at funeral homes, to being involved on the day of the funeral Mass of the Resurrection. You don't even need to be retired, but it is an advantage to being able to be available.

All I am asking from anyone who attends the information session is to come with an open heart,

ready to listen to what the Holy Spirit has in God's mind for you. So many people in our current world do not know what it means to connect with others at the depths of the soul. Despite what some others may think, it's also a talent that can be learned. And attending the meeting does not mean that you are signing up unless you want to. It's a no pressure meeting.

In the same train of thought, I have also recently found out that the Archdiocese is having a Bereavement Training Day on Saturday, November 23rd at 9am at St Gianna Parish in Evergreen Park (Queen of Martyrs campus). I don't know all of what the day will cover; however, if our meeting on the 14th peaks your interest, attending the training day might solidify a decision to join our St. Cletus Compassionate Care Ministry or not.

Ministry to grieving families is an essential aspect to helping people to heal from losses of any type. There are very few things in this world that are more stressful or are causes for depression than the death of a loved one. Your heart is the only thing you need; God gives the rest.







AARP Tax-Aide Needs Volunteers for the 2025 Tax Filing Season

Looking for a rewarding opportunity to make a difference in your community?

The AARP Tax-Aide Program is now seeking volunteers for the upcoming 2025 tax filing season. It's not necessary for you to be an AARP member or to have a tax or an accounting background to volunteer. However, some knowledge of your own personal tax matters is very helpful. All returns are prepared on computers; thus, volunteers should be somewhat computer literate. Training classes will be held in January, 2025. Minimum time commitment during the filing season is 4 to 5 hours one day per week from early February to mid-April.


This income tax preparation and assistance service is offered to low and middle income individuals with special attention to those 60 years and older. Won't you help?


