Dear Friends,

As you start your day, dutifully fulfill your responsibilities, and return home; how often do you pause to ponder and become aware of the presence of God in your life? If you do so, what happens? What is the experience like? Do you share it with anyone?

As members of St. Cletus Parish, every day we are blessed with opportunities to notice, celebrate, and share with one another the real presence of God in our midst. Consider how God makes himself present to us through all the kindness, care, and love that we share and receive. Consider also how God comes and speaks to you any time you are greeted and welcomed with love by our generous and kind ministers as you come to Mass. We are a parish community that delights in radiating the closeness and love of God to all who come to worship him with us. This fills my heart with gratitude, peace, and joy. Thank you.

One of the many parish groups who radiate the closeness and presence of God in our midst are the members of the St. Fiacre Society Ministry. Since 2021 moved by the love of God and St. Cletus, they have kept the parish grounds and gardens always looking warm, welcoming, and beautiful. We will conclude the day (10/23) by coming together to pray the rosary at 7:00 PM in our church. I am encouraged by the generosity and leadership of so many, who have been praying and working together for this special moment in the life of our parish. I believe it will be a very good experience of community and prayer. Together we will experience the closeness of God through our Blessed Mother, Virgin Mary. Hope you can join us.

May our experience of the closeness of God in our lives continue to grow.

## A letter from the Associate Pastor's Desk

Prayer in conversation

Several years ago, I began really getting into journaling, which led to me doing more writing than I ever imagined. It has been great for my prayer life. However, there was a day when I was in a real stretch of writers block. It was very frustrating. Then I thought about one of the seminary professors who always seemed to be able to get my creative juices flowing. So, I called him. "Mikey (that's how he addressed me), how are you?" "I need a subject to write about. I am at a roadblock." He responded "Well, it's interesting you bring this today. You see I have been thinking about how the Blessed Virgin Mother is the ultimate prayer partner." We talked for a little longer, but I really had heard all I needed to hear.

We speak of prayer as being a conversation – one side speaks, one listens, then the other speaks, back and forth. Good conversations can go on for hours at a time. So, when Fr. Larry spoke about the Blessed Mother being the ultimate prayer partner, I loved it. I'll give you some of those writings at a later date. But one of those conversations with Mary revolved around the rosary. With this Wednesday being the evening we are being invited to pray the rosary together, I remember just how good it was to have those conversations. Now don't get me wrong. I was not praying TO Mary, but with her. I was asking for her help in trying to understand more about Jesus' life and how she was His biggest follower.

So I began thinking about the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary – The Annunciation, The Visitation, The Nativity, The Presentation of Jesus, and the Finding of Jesus in the Temple. And while we are not using these mysteries the Wednesday evening, it was a very intense conversation.

I started, of course, with the Sign of the Cross, the Apostles Creed, the Our Father, the first three Hail Mary's, and the Glory Be. That is how to begin each rosary we pray. Then we move into the mysteries themselves, in essence taking time to reflect on the events for what they are. For this example, I began thinking about the Annunciation. I began asking Mary about the experience. Questions popped in my head about her reaction to Gabriel's appearance, how she wasn't afraid, how she trusted God's messenger at such an early age, and more. Then, she told me to pray that first Our Father. With each subsequent Hail Mary, she reminded me of the experiences, breaking down the experience by highlighting verses for me, finishing the mystery with the Glory Be; and then, onto The Visitation, and so on. It was fascinating.

Do you think you could have a conversation like this someday with Mary? If you have already, please share it. It's a very humbling exercise.
